From the Pastor's Desk

We are one in the Spirit, we are one in the Lord... ***Ephesians 4:1-17***

This is the sentimental theme of Church life... We can get warm fuzzies as we hold hands in a circle and gently sway as we sing these words; believing, at least for a few moments, that all is right in the world because we are of one mind.

So you ask, what's wrong with that. Nothing really, as long as the truth of that does not end when the feelings end. Being one in the Spirit is what Christ has offered and provided to the church as a source of hope and strength and community.

This does seem to be a rare reality in most congregations however, because there is a difference between being together and being one. The main difference is the phrase "one in the Lord". Under the Lordship of Christ, there are many gifts but one Spirit. There are many laborers but only one Lord. Being one in ministry means being one in service. All are working together for the same purpose, to glorify the Father in heaven.

So like all things, 'the proof of the pudding is in the eating'. Right? You don't know if you're actually 'one' until the pressure is on. You can't be sure if you can count on someone until the test comes, until you are in over your head and can't do it on your own. At these moments, these very trying, scary, challenging even desperate moments, that's when your faith is tested. It is during these times that...



...your faith is only as good as the object in which you place your faith. Placing your faith in the stock market, your job, your spouse, your friends - anything or anyone - has built-in limitations that you must be aware of upfront. It is only Christ that never fails. It is only Christ that never forsakes, never waivers, never abandons, and never leaves.

So that takes us back to our song, our mantra. We are One only because there is only One Spirit, and we are one only when that Spirit is the One Lord over all. As I am in Christ and surrendered totally to Him, I become more and more faithful and able to stand with you as long as you also are in Christ and surrendered to His Lordship. Below is a classic photo of construction workers on a lunch break as they sit on a beam of the 'under construction' Chrysler Building in 1929. There seems to be a level of trust,



brotherhood and peace that most churches would love to have within their congregations. When people live and work together in a relationship like this, there is no fear. A close look at the men reveals them smiling, sharing, and at perfect rest. Totally comfortable being together without regard to the surrounding danger or treacherous circumstances of the world. May the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ grant such peace and trust to His children at Riverton. *One Lord, One Faith, One Baptism, one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all.*


Using Technology to Help Us Grow

Resurrection iWitness is just one in a series of apps written and designed by graphic artist and musician Doug Powell. Designed original as a hardcover book, each page is designed with content that opens up and pulls out of the envelopes or opens up to reveal images or answers to questions. The apps are designed like the books. You swipe open an envelope to reveal the answer to the Swoon theory, for example. Innovative and creative, this is a great way for your families to explore the facts of the resurrection together.

Resurrection iWitness uses the minimal facts approach to explore the following theories to prove Jesus rose from the dead:


- The Swoon Theory




Truth For Life App - The Bible Teaching Ministry of Alistair Begg



Cold Case Christianity App- Ministry of J. Warner Wallace a former atheist and cold case homicide detective, his wife asked him to attend church with her. They went to Saddleback Church. The pastor said enough to make him think Jesus was at least worth reading about. Part of his family had been Mormon so he began researching the truth claims of each using techniques he used in his cold case work, and found the Mormon truth claims gravely lacking. On the other hand, evidence for the Bible was very credible. J. Warner Wallace became a Christian, a youth minister, graduated from seminary, and put the evidence for the Bible in his book, *Cold Case Christianity*.

App Features:

- Weekly Podcast on various topics about how to talk to skeptics about Christian truth claims, how to prepare your children to defend their worldview, how to think critically when considering truth claims, and how to boldly engage those around us with the Gospel.
- Access to article topics such as Biblical reliability, Christian living, evangelism, and cultural issues of the day

Cross Examined App- Ministry of Dr. Frank Turek seeking to present evidence that the Bible is true and equipping Christians to share that truth boldly with skeptics. Dr. Turek has authored several books most recently, *Stealing From God*, how atheist ground their morality in God despite their claims to the contrary.

- Podcast of weekly radio show featuring interviews and callers to the show.
- The quick answers section on this app is especially helpful. It has 4 sections with quick facts about Truth, God, the Bible, and the 4 Es which are Evolution/Creation, Evil, Ethics, and Eternity.

Reasonable Faith App- Ministry of Dr. William Lane Craig- Professor of Research Philosophy at Talbot School of Theology and Professor of Philosophy at Houston Baptist University, Dr. Craig speaks and debates on issues regarding the existence of God, the meaning of life, objective truth, the foundation of moral values, creation of the universe, and other foundational Biblical topics. An app for those who want to be challenged intellectually!

- A weekly podcast discussing topics of the day.


Thank you, Jesus, for taking my sins to the cross.


