Follow up. What's next for you? I have some ideas, but I believe the Lord will give you some ideas as well. I also believe from experience that God will use you where you are. I don't think God's plan was for everyone to do the same thing, or go to the same place.

To the rich and young who feel 'self-sufficient' and to the broken and hopeless who feel forgotten and alone. 
Music Notes \$15


