We get the name from the Latin Vulgate, in turn borrowed or transliterated from Greek γένεοις, meaning "origin"; in Hebrew: שָׁרָרָאשָׁיה, "In [the] beginning"). The authorship is traditionally and historically and biblically attributed to Moses. Others may have contributed to its final version but largely this along with the next four books are credited to Moses.

You and I are about to dive into an exciting look at this amazing revelation of God and find out the truths about our origins, our purpose and our destiny. Over the next 20 weeks we will look at some of the basic stories of our Judeo/Christian foundations as well as take some time to dig a little deeper into the Astronomy, Biology and Physics of our existence. We may even get into a little Advanced Math and Probability. Wow, doesn't that sound exciting? Every Sunday our messages will focus on the what the Holy Spirit is saying to us about how our past informs our present, and our future. We will learn that these familiar stories are not just for Sunday school, but actually define every Theological belief and all point to the importance and centrality of the Cross.

With the help of one of our own scholars, Trish Anderson, and others, we will dive into some of the most interesting subjects that surround our Faith. Every Wednesday evening we will offer classes where we can all dig deeper into the Biblical text and ancient stories revealed on Sunday.
