- **1. Joy.** As you look closely you will see joy in the faces of the children, youth and adults. You can see the excitement and enthusiasm and if you were here you would have heard it as well. The entire campus of Riverton was buzzing with the Joy of of the Lord. There is an unmistakable, deep-rooted feeling of Joy that comes when one is in the presence of so many brothers and sisters in Christ and in the tangible presence of the Almighty, Jesus Christ in Whom we live and move and exist.
- **2. Sacrifice**. We are all busy, and busyness has become the number one reason most of us do not get as involved as we would like. But the assumption that "others are less busy than me" is not true. These folks have very busy lives as well but as many as 75 different Rivertonians (young and not young) poured hours of their lives toward this ministry and by doing so, poured into the lives of these 100+ children the very Love and Joy of Christ. Sacrifice simply means choosing to doing something for others, and for God rather than yourself. When we speak of Godly sacrifice the over-arching principle is **stewardship.** Making decisions with our time, our talent and our treasure that will reflect our heart's motives and the faithfulness of our hands. "What have we done with what we have been given?"
- **3. Worship.** From the opening movies and dialog to lively music, the children were taught about an amazing God who is the reason that all of this is happening. With science experiments that create awe and wonder and Bible stories that make the ancient stories come to life the children (and adults) became more acquainted with the Awesome God of the universe in whom we exist. Children and their parents learned that God deserves our praise and singing, dancing and having fun is a perfect way to praise Him. From my perspective, young and old alike walked away with a greater understanding of how welcoming, relevant and exciting being a part of a church can be.

I continually thank my God for the privilege of serving along side of the saints at Riverton. I was taught that age, ability, busyness, fatigue or experience were not legitimate excuses to keep me from being the hands and feet of Christ.

I am so blessed and motivated to go and do and be more for Christ! Thank You!
